

REDEN INVESTS IN CLEAN ENERGY IN MOLISE

Marking a major step in its commitment to sustainable energy, REDEN has inaugurated two new photovoltaic power plants in Montenero di Bisaccia (CB), Southern Italy. With a combined capacity of 14 MW, these installations power over 7,000 households and prevent the emission of 13,000 tons of CO₂ per year into the atmosphere.

The Montenero 1 and Montenero 2 projects reflect REDEN's dedication to environmental preservation and biodiversity enhancement. They integrate solar electricity production with local agriculture, featuring the planting of olive trees, vines and fruit trees, in support of sustainability and the energy transition.

Roquefort (Agen), France / Rome, Italy, May 22, 2025 — REDEN, a leading international producer of photovoltaic energy and storage systems, has inaugurated today two new solar power plants in Montenero di Bisaccia, located in the province of Campobasso. Named "Montenero 1" and "Montenero 2," these projects symbolise the Group's commitment to a clean energy future and the sustainable development of photovoltaics in Italy.

Built with the latest technologies and a deep respect for the environment, the photovoltaic plants have a total installed capacity of 14 MW. They produce 21,7 GWh annually and avoid the emission of over 13,000 tons of CO₂ into the atmosphere, equivalent to avoiding 60 million kilometres driven by internal combustion vehicles. The construction of the two photovoltaic plants was entrusted to Altenia, a company belonging to the Terna Energy Solutions Group.

The facilities balance energy production with landscape conservation and biodiversity enhancement. Olive trees, vines and fruit trees have been planted throughout the sites, fostering a thriving, sustainable ecosystem that revitalises the landscape and brings tangible environmental, economic and social benefits to the local community. The green electricity produced contributes to the region's energy independence, accelerating Molise's transition to a zero-emission energy system.

"With the Montenero 1 and 2 projects, we strengthen our presence in Italy and reaffirm our vision of a renewable energy deeply integrated into local communities, paving the way to a greener future while respecting the history of the regions that host us," said Luca CRISI, Country Manager of REDEN Italy. "We have worked in close collaboration with the many stakeholders and institutions to achieve this significant milestone. REDEN sees Italy as one of its most important markets globally. Guided by core values — ethics, sustainability, and respect for the land — we are committed to developing projects that enhance community living conditions, reduce pollution and preserve natural landscapes."

Also present at the inauguration, Simona CONTUCCI, Mayor of Montenero di Bisaccia, highlighted the fruitful collaboration between REDEN and the local administration: "It was a moment where best practices came together. As a municipality, we support the development of renewable energy, provided it is implemented in already compromised areas such as this one, notably due to the presence of a nearby wastewater treatment plant."





The inauguration of the Montenero 1 and 2 plants underscores REDEN's dedication to a resilient, decentralised and low-impact energy model. These projects position Italy as a strategic focal point for REDEN's expansion in the renewable energy sector, forging the path for future initiatives driving sustainable growth across the region.
